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#### Overview

This document is intended for Insight 9.4 customers who want to install patch 9.4-17972-4. The document describes the enhancements and fixes included in the patch and provides procedures for installation of the patch.

#### **Fixes**

II-10449	Fixed an issue that caused reports to be duplicated.
II-10450	Fixed an issue that prevented filtering from working correctly.

#### Patch Installation

The attached zip file, II-9.4-17972-4.zip, contains all the files you need to install the patch for the Insight server.

- Copy or upload II-9.4-17972-4.zip to install folder/Infogix/maintenance/updates/II.
- 2. From <code>install\_folder/Infogix/bin</code>, run the update product script to apply the patch. If your Insight installation uses a configuration name, such as test, specify <code>-c configname</code> in the script commands below. Otherwise, omit the <code>-c configname</code> argument.
  - Windows®: update-product.bat -c configname apply II-9.4-17972-4 II
  - UNIX or Linux:
    ./update-product.sh -c configname apply II-9.4-17972-4 II
    where -c configname specifies your configuration name (if any).
- 3. If this is a new installation or an upgrade, skip the additional steps that follow and return to the installation process in the server installation or upgrade guide.

#### Additional Steps for Pre-Existing Installations

If you are applying the patch to a pre-existing installation, complete the remaining steps below.

1. Run the clean script from <code>install\_folder/Infogix/bin</code>. This script cleans out all working files and drivers added to the installation folder

since the previous deployment.

o Windows:

```
clean.bat -c configname II
```

O UNIX or Linux:

```
./clean.sh -c configname II
```

The -c configname argument is only necessary if your installation uses a configuration name.

- 2. Run the deploy script from install folder/Infogix/bin.
- o Windows:

```
deploy.bat -c configname II
```

o UNIX or Linux:

```
./deploy.sh -c configname II
```

The -c configname argument is only necessary if your installation uses a configuration name.

3. Restart the Insight server.
